



## Cambodian Student Ambassadors – Give back to their community

The Cambodian Cisco Networking Academy Student Ambassadors recently held an event to help support the non-profit organization, Goutte D'Eau. Goutte D'Eau was founded by humanitarian professionals who saw a need to coordinate local NGOs working with Cambodian children. Goutte D'Eau's partners employ some 400 local staff who care for over 3000 vulnerable children.



Held on Saturday the 10th of October, 2009, 25 student ambassadors from Asia Euro University who had recently graduated from the IT Essentials PC Hardware and Software course volunteered their time visiting Dom Nok Tek organisation to repair 40 lap tops that were donated by the Swiss Zealand organisation to Goutte D'Eau.
